## *First Five County Recycling Workshop is a Huge Success*

The first-ever five County Recycling Consortium for Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Morris, and Passaic Counties was held on Wednesday, March 27<sup>th</sup> at the Rock Springs Golf Club in West Orange and was a



huge success with over 85 attendees. Officials from all five counties came together to hear presentations from Recycle Coach, Morris County, IWS, Machinex, and others.

Recycle Coach's Kim Stuart discussed the various features and capabilities of Recycle Coach. Recycle Coach is a state funded program since 2017 and is available in 564 municipalities as a mobile site and a web app.

Anthony Marrone, Morris County's Recycling Coordinator discussed municipal websites and how to improve recycling communication.

Next up was Wayne DeFeo of DeFeo Associates and Essex County. He was on hand to discuss a possible bottle bill and the downside of it for recycling in New Jersey. He addressed the different groups that are supporting and opposing a bottle bill.

## MSW Recycling and Disposal Facts

- For 2021, New Jersey generated 10,059,297 tons of municipal solid waste (MSW).
- Municipalities (and in limited instances, counties) reported recycling 3,770,132 tons of MSW and disposing 6,289,165 tons of MSW.
- New Jersey experienced a MSW recycling rate of 37 percent in 2021, a decrease from the 2020 rate of 39 percent.

Compared with data from 2020, the total tonnage of MSW recycled slightly decreased in 2021. In addition, the amount of MSW disposed of increased, leading to a small decrease in the MSW recycling rate.

The MSW disposal and recycling data translates to New Jersey residents disposing of 3.7 pounds of solid waste and 2.2 pounds of recycling per person per day in 2021.



Compared with data from 2020, there was an increase in the total solid waste disposal amounts per person, while the recycling amount stayed consistent.

## U.S. Senate Passes Bills to Improve Recycling and Increase Composting

In an effort to improve and expand recycling service and increase composting programs, the U.S. Senate passed two bipartisan bills that seek to boost recycling and composting infrastructure in communities across the country. By unanimous consent, the U.S. Senate approved the Recycling Infrastructure and Accessibility Act (S. 1189) and the Recycling and Composting Accountability Act (S. 1194) in March. These bills will help build recycling and composting infrastructure projects, improve rural recycling, boost data collection, and explore opportunities for implementing a national composting strategy.
